

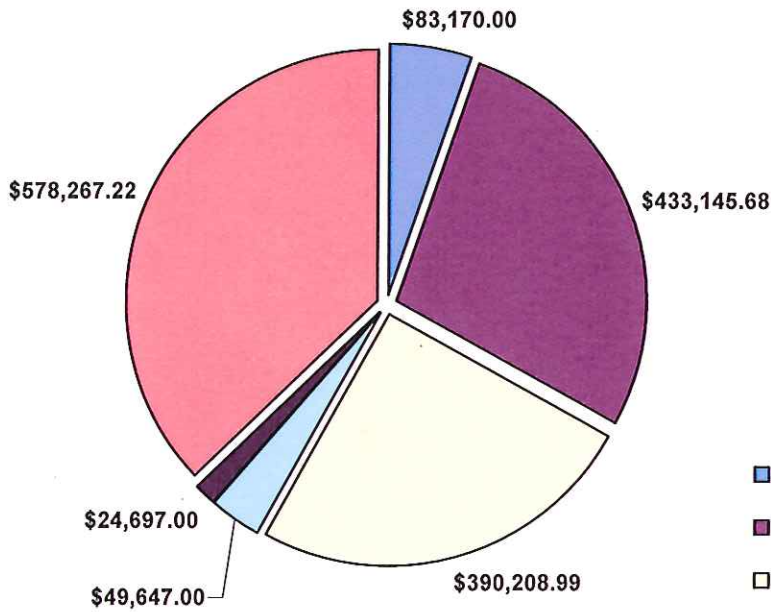

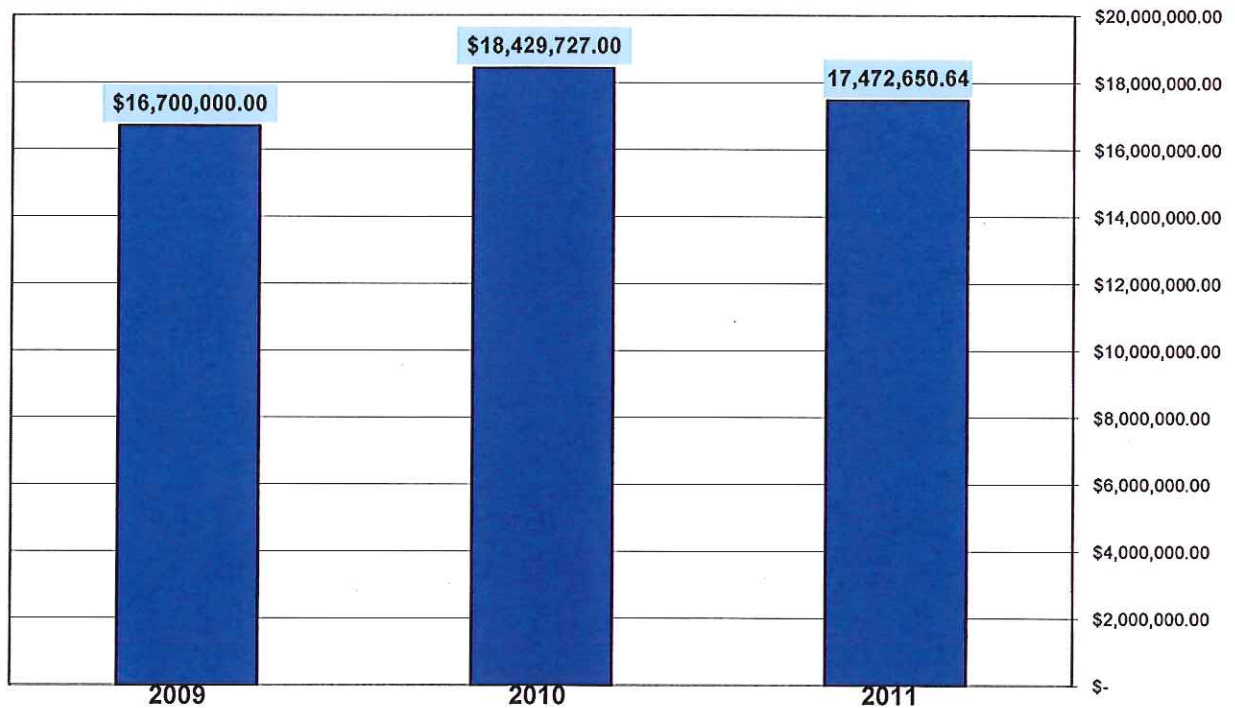


2011 Grants went to more than 200 Non Profits

The American Leadership Forum (ALF) was founded in 1980 to create a regional network of diverse senior-level leaders across private, public and nonprofit sectors. ALF Fellows and Senior Fellows now number more than 2,500 people nationwide.

In the Waccamaw Region (Horry and Georgetown), we have created a network that brings together a broad cross-section of leaders committed to building a stronger community.

Since 2009, the WALF program has graduated 36 exceptional people (now Sr. Fellows) from the Horry and Georgetown region.
